
【3/27 犹他新冠疫情简要日报 6:00pm 山地时间】



The growth of coronavirus cases in Utah follows subexponential growth (green line, p=0.73), slower than exponential growth (red line, p=1), faster than linear growth (blue line, p=0). Note: the range for the growth parameter p is [0, 1]; the larger the p-value, the faster the growth.

- 3) House passes \$2.2 trillion stimulus package (Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, CARES Act). The senate version of the bill has been passed with 96-0 on Wednesday. The CARES Act has been signed by President Trump and become effective today. Status of resident alien is qualified to receive one-time payments. https://www.congress.gov/bill/116th-congress/senate-bill/3548/text
