

1. 美国 – 截止 6pm MDT·全国确诊新冠病毒病例: 277,180 (自昨晚 6pm +33,243)。死亡: 6,975(+1,061)·治愈: 9,772(+770)。 (https://coronavirus.1point3acres.com/)

- 2. 犹他州卫生厅 UDOH 中午公布的确诊新冠病毒病例 1,246(+172) · 总共测试 24,248 人 · 阳性率 5.14%; 其中住院人数累计 106(+6) · 死亡病例累计 7 · 犹他州新冠病毒病例的增长仍然为亚指数增长 (p=0.71): http://castut.org/covid-19/utah0403.jpg · 主要分布的郡(区): Salt Lake 541(+65), Summit 222(+18), Utah 150(+45), Davis 122(+19), Wasatch 69(+8) · 年龄分布: 0-14 2%; 15-24 15% · 25-44 40% · 45-64 31% · 65+ 12% · 性别分布: 男性 54% · 女性 46% ·
- 3. 经过白宫内部一周的慎重考虑,川普政府宣布开始推荐民众戴上 "非医用、布质" 面罩 (Non-medial Cloth Face Covering)。
- 3. 美国国务院 (Department of State) 已经将国际旅行警报级别提高到第四级(最高级)。要求 美国人避免任何国际旅行,在外旅行的美国人尽快安排行程回国除非计划在国外无限期逗留。同 时国务院会联系行商业航班协助公民返美,要求愿意返美的公民与就近使领馆联系。在未来随着

- 6. 犹他所有州公园现在仅对所在郡的居民开放。此外犹他州境内的锡安国家公园、拱门国家公园和峡谷底国家公园因受疫情影响现已关闭。Lake Powell 将于本周末关闭。



The growth of coronavirus cases in Utah follows subexponential growth (green line, p = 0.71), slower than exponential growth (red line, p = 1), faster than linear growth (blue line, p = 0). Note: the range for the growth parameter p is [0, 1]; the larger the p-value, the faster the growth.

- 1. U.S. Confirmed Cases: 277,180 (+33,243), Deaths: 6,975(+1,061), Recovered:9,772(+770). (https://coronavirus.1point3acres.com/).
- 2. Utah COVID-19 Cases reported by UDOH as of today: 1,246(+172) confirmed cases total, number of people tested 24,248, positive rate 5.14%; Hospitalization 106(+6), death cases 7. The growth of coronavirus cases in Utah remains subexponential (p=0.71): http://www.castut.org/covid-19/utah0403en.jpg Major counties of distribution: Salt Lake 541(+65), Summit 222(+18), Utah 150(+45), Davis 122(+19), Wasatch 69(+8). Age distribution: 0-14 2%; 15-24 15%, 25-44 40%, 45-64 31%, 65+12%. Gender distribution: male 54%, female 46%.
- 3. After deliberations within the White House, Trump Administration is now recommending to wear "non-medical cloth" face coverings. (https://twitter.com/WhiteHouse/status/1246198244411084800)
- 3. The Department of State (DOS) advises United States citizens to avoid all international travel amid the COVID-19 pandemic. US citizens who live in countries with commercial departure options available should immediately arrange for return, unless they are prepared to stay aboard for an indefinite period.

The DOS is making all efforts to assist US citizens living overseas who wish to return to the US. For US citizens who wish to return should make arrangements with nearest Embassy or Consulate for needed assistance. - 4. FDA to allow imports of KN95 masks from China amid PPE shortage. Due to the concerns over the quality of products, FDA did not authorize KN95 masks under Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) previously. https://www.fda.gov/medical-devices/personal-protective-equipment-infection-control/faqs-shortages-surgical-masks-and-gowns#kn95
- 5. At the Governor's Press Conference, UDOH announced the availability of ICU beds, ventilators and PPE. Alternative care sites with 255 beds are set up and additional 750 beds will be available for moving in current non-COVID-19 patients. The State is also arranging shelters and quarantine sites for those who do not have a place to appropriately quarantine. The state also calls for volunteers with medical skills to help at https://coronavirus.utah.gov/help.
- 6. Utah State Parks are closed to non-county residents. Zion National Park, Arches National Park and Canyonlands are closed amid COVID-19 concerns. Also, Lake Powell will be closed over the weekend.
