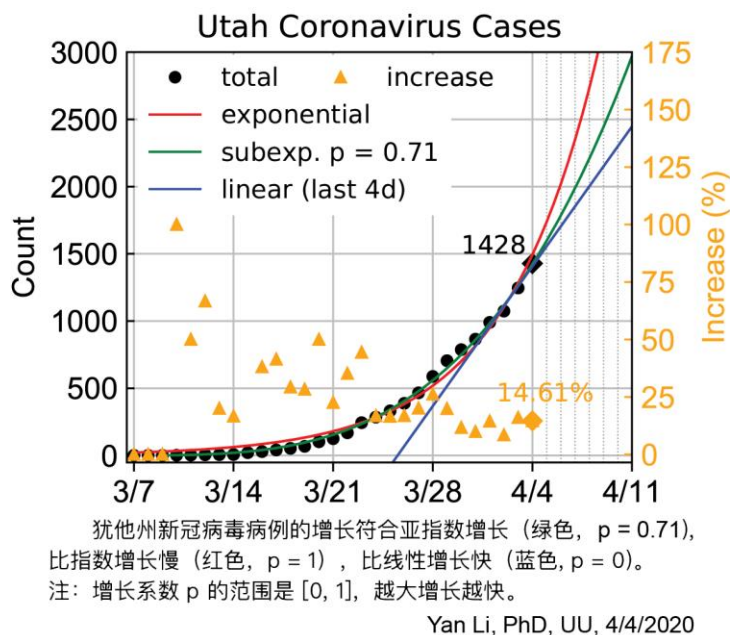

【04/04 犹他新冠疫情简要日报 6:00pm 山地时间】

===疫情期安全措施：自我隔离、保持 6 英尺距离、平静面对、远程工作和病症咨询===



1. 美国 – 截止 6pm MDT · 全国确诊新冠病毒病例: 310,609 (自昨晚 6pm +33,429) · 死亡: 8,461(+1,486) · 治愈: 14,661(+4,889) · (<https://coronavirus.1point3acres.com/>)

2. 犹他州卫生厅 UDOH 中午公布的确诊新冠病毒病例 1,428(+182) · 总共测试 28,043 人 · 阳性率 5.09%；其中住院人数累计 117(+11) · 占总病例的 8.19%；死亡病例累计 8(+1) · 死亡率 0.56%。犹他州新冠病毒病例的增长仍然为亚指数增长 ($p=0.71$)：<http://castut.org/covid-19/utah0404.jpg>。主要分布的郡(区)：Salt Lake 650(+109), Summit 230(+8), Utah 186(+36), Davis 137(+15), Wasatch 70(+1)。

3. 副州长 Cox 推文：“犹他现在是全美人均测试数第五高的州！不幸的是如同很多州一样，我们开始缺乏采样棉签和标本转送管。我们要保持我们的成绩。如果你有这些用品，请送邮件至 benhard@utah.gov。犹他大学医学院的健康公车（此前用于“扫除糖尿病”的行动）现已被改装成具有 COVID-19 测试能力的车辆，并为 Wasatch Front 的社区提供检测。

4. 犹他公交管理局宣布自 4 月 5 日起削减公共汽车、轻轨和 FrontRunner 的班次，新的时刻表见 <http://www.rideuta.com/April>。州驾驶执照司延长了一些服务地点的工作时间，并敦促驾车者尽可能地使用该部门的网上服务，见 <https://dmv.utah.gov/>。

6. 犹他州卫生厅报告，在盐湖郡的一个护理院里，6 个有症病人测试呈新冠病毒感染阳性，其中一位 85 岁以上的女性患者于 4 月 2 日去世；其他病人正在等待测试结果，呈阴性者将被转移。这个有 34 张床位的护理院将收留出院后新冠病人。

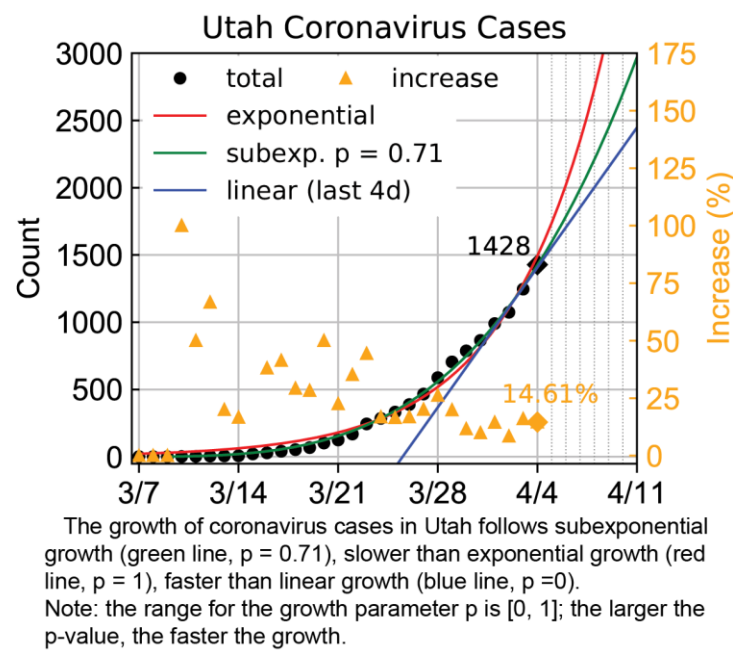

1. U.S. Confirmed Cases: 310,609 (+33,429), Deaths: 8,461(+1,468), Recovered:14,661(+4,889).

2. Utah COVID-19 Cases reported by UDOH as of today: 1,428(+182) confirmed cases total, number of people tested 28,043, positive rate 5.09%; Hospitalization 117(+11), 8.19% of the total cases; death cases 8(+1), death rate 0.56%. The growth of coronavirus cases in Utah remains sub-exponential ($p=0.71$): <http://www.castut.org/covid-19/utah0404en.jpg>. Major counties of distribution: Salt Lake 650(+109), Summit 230(+8), Utah 186(+36), Davis 137(+15), Wasatch 70(+1).

3. Lt. Gov. Cox tweeted, "Utah is now 5th in the nation in testing per capita! Unfortunately like many states we are starting to run low on swabs and transport medium. We don't want to lose ground, so if you have access to these supplies please email benhart@utah.gov. Also, Wellness Bus – U of U Health's Wellness Bus, normally used for the Driving Out Diabetes Initiative, has been outfitted with COVID-19

testing capabilities. The Wellness Bus is now providing coronavirus testing in underserved communities along the Wasatch Front.

4. The Utah Transit Authority announced that bus, TRAX and FrontRunner service will be less frequent beginning April 5. For a new schedule see <http://www.rideuta.com/April>. The Utah Division of Motor Vehicles is extending hours at some locations and urging drivers to use online services if possible, at <https://dmv.utah.gov/>.

6. UDOH reported that six symptomatic patients have tested positive for COVID-19 at a Salt Lake City nursing facility. One of those patients, a woman over age 85, died on April 2. Test results are pending on the remaining residents and those who test negative for COVID-19 will be transferred to another facility. The 34-bed facility will now serve as a space for COVID-19 patients who no longer require hospitalization.
