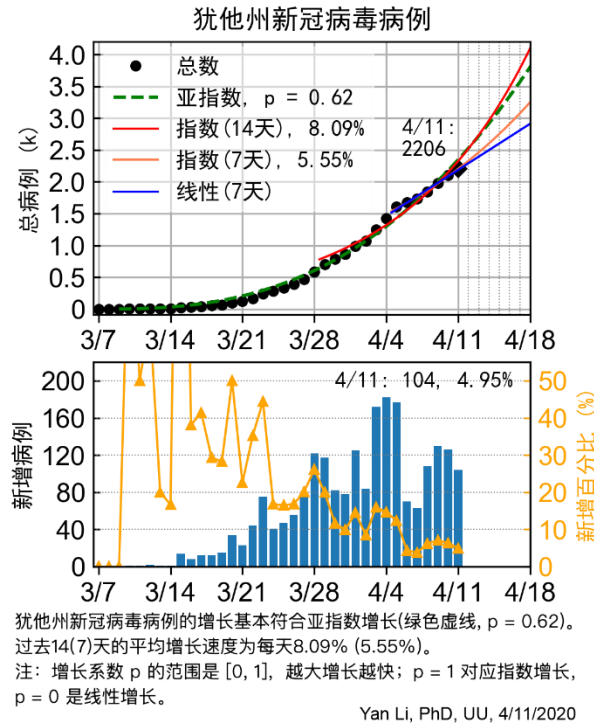


群力战新冠 爱心献犹他

【04/11 犹他新冠疫情简要日报 6:00pm 山地时间】

===疫情期安全措施：自我隔离、保持 6 英尺距离、平静面对、远程工作和病症咨询===



1. 美国 – 截止 6pm MDT, 全国确诊新冠病毒病例: 531,466 (自昨晚 6pm +28,037)。死亡: 20,549(+1,872), 治愈: 31,424(+2,634)。(<https://coronavirus.1point3acres.com/>)
2. 犹他州卫生厅中午公布的确证新冠病毒病例 2,206(+104), 总共测试 42,546 人, 阳性率 5.18%; 其中住院人数累计 190(+7), 占总病例的 8.61%; 死亡病例累计 18(+1), 死亡率 0.82%; 治愈 26 人 (1point3acres.com 数据)。犹他州新冠病毒病例的增长基本符合亚指数增长($p=0.62$): <http://castut.org/covid-19/utah0411.png>。过去 14 天平均增长率为每天 8.09%, 过去 7 天为每天 5.55%。郡(区)分布: Salt Lake 1071(+60), Summit 300(+4), Utah 295(+12), Davis 193(+13), Wasatch 98(+2), Weber-Morgan 93(+3), Southwest Utah 53(+1), Bear River 45(+3), Tooele 31(+3), TriCounty 8, San Juan 8(+2), Central Utah 6, Southeast Utah 5(+1)。
3. Wasatch 郡卫生署宣布新增的死亡病例是男性, 60 岁以上, 有基础病, 去世前因新冠病毒在一个盐湖城的医院住院 9 天。
4. 总结盐湖郡的疫情, 并识别出受疫情影响最严重的区域。以每十万人确诊病例作为标准, 盐湖城市中心所在的 84101 邮编区域有 315.1 例确诊, 为受影响最严重的区域。其次是邮编 84104 对应的区域, 每十万人有 188.3 人确诊。然后是邮编 84116 对应的区域, 每十万人有 157 人确诊。详情请见: <https://www.sltrib.com/news/2020/04/10/utah-reports-four-more/>。

5. Intermountain Healthcare 将派遣两个由 50 名成员组成的 COVID-19 救援团队前往纽约市帮助长老会医院和 Northwell Health 医院因新冠病毒大流行而遭受严重的人员短缺。他们将在那里部署两个星期。作为回报, Intermountain 期望当犹他州面对大量 COVID-19 患者潮时, 能够从纽约卫生系统获得帮助。

6. 警察在 Wayne 县 Happy Valley 小木屋居住地区逮捕了一名 66 岁的男子, 因为警方认为他殴打邻居是因为他相信邻居没有遵守州长的“保持安全, 待在家里”的指示。该男子被控犯有两项严重加重攻击和 DUI 罪。

7. 四月十四号下午六点半, 犹他州华人众议员关玉嫌、Verona Sagato Mauga 和犹他州日裔参议员 Jani Iwamoto 等人将组织举办线上社区讨论。讨论的主题是关于“COVID-19 和犹他亚裔美国人及太平洋岛民”。请发邮件至 VeronaMauga@gmail.com 获取登陆信息。宣传海报请见:

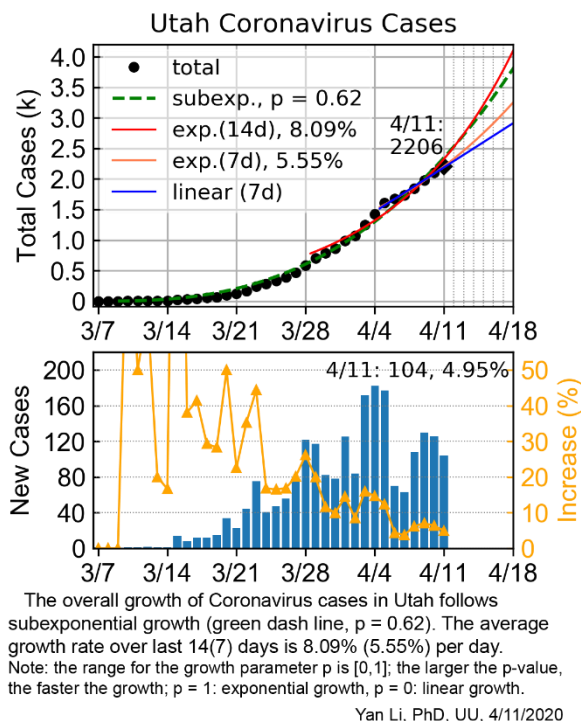

1. U.S. Confirmed Cases: 531,466(+28,037), Deaths: 20,549(+1,872), Recovered:31,424(+2,634).

2. Utah COVID-19 Cases reported by Utah Department of Health as of today: 2,206(+104) confirmed cases total, number of people tested 42,546, positive rate 5.18%; Hospitalization 190(+7), 8.61% of the total cases; death cases 18(+1), death rate 0.82%; recovered cases 26 (data from 1point3acres.com). The growth of coronavirus cases in Utah has been mainly following subexponential growth trend ($p=0.62$): <http://www.castut.org/covid-19/utah0411en.png>. The average growth is 8.09% per day for the last 14 days, and 5.55% for the last 7 days. Distribution in counties (areas): Salt Lake 1071(+60), Summit 300(+4), Utah 295(+12), Davis 193(+13), Wasatch 98(+2), Weber-Morgan 93(+3), Southwest Utah 53(+1), Bear River 45(+3), Tooele 31(+3), TriCounty 8, San Juan 8(+2), Central Utah 6, Southeast Utah 5(+1).

3. Wasatch County Health Director said the new death case is a man, older than 60, who had been fighting the virus at a Salt Lake City hospital for nine days. The man also had underlying health conditions.

4. The areas hit hardest by the coronavirus have been identified in Salt Lake County. The highest level of cases is 84101 ZIP code, the heart of Salt Lake City downtown, which reports 315.1 cases per 100,000 populations. The second-highest rate belongs to 84104 ZIP code, which reports 188.3 cases per 100,000 populations, following by ZIP code 84116, reporting a rate of 157. 5. Intermountain Healthcare will send two 50-member COVID-19 response teams to New York City and help Presbyterian and Northwell Health hospitals experiencing severe staffing shortages due to the pandemic. They will be deployed there for two weeks. In return, Intermountain expects helping from the New York health systems when Utah faces a surge of COVID-19 patients.

6. A man was arrested at a cabin area in the Happy Valley, Wayne County after police say he assaulted his neighbors because he believed they weren't following the governor's "stay safe, stay home" directive. He was under investigation of two counts of aggravated assault and DUI.

Since the outbreak of the Novel Coronavirus in the United States, with the active advocacy of the Chinese Utahns Alliance Against Coronavirus/COVID-19, initiated by the Chinese Association for Science and Technology in Utah (CAST-UT) and other organizations, Chinese Utahns have actively donated money and PPEs supplies to local hospitals, police offices and Red Cross organizations to support the fight against the epidemic.
