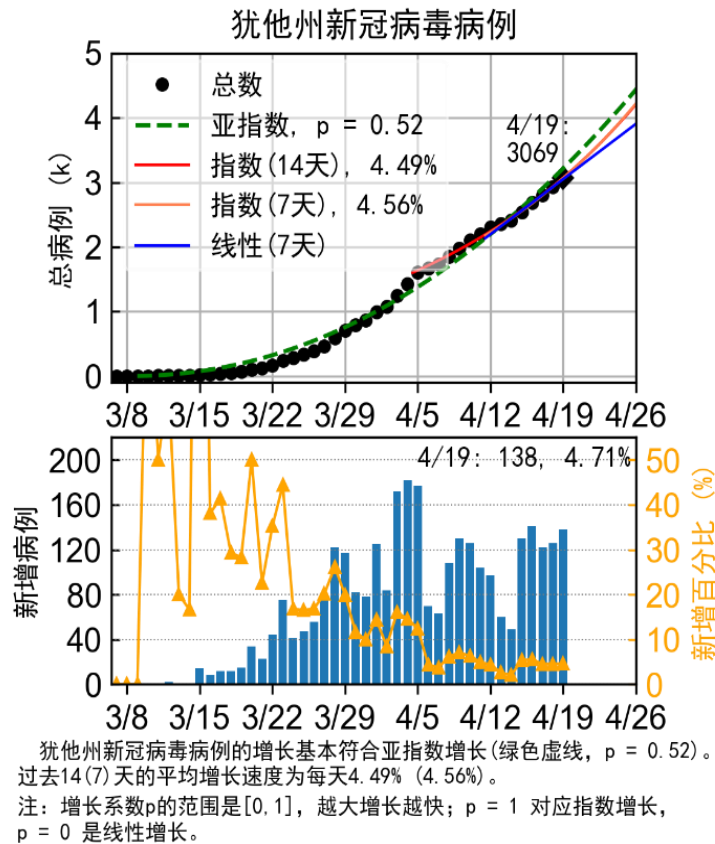

1. 美国 – 截止 6pm MDT, 全国确诊新冠病毒病例: 765,954 (自昨晚 6pm +25,696)。死亡: 40,677(+1,613), 治愈: 70,337(+4,645)。(<https://coronavirus.1point3acres.com/>)
2. 犹他州卫生厅中午公布的确诊新冠病毒病例 3,069(+138), 总共测试 63,555 人, 阳性率 4.83%; 其中住院人数累计 259(+8), 占总病例的 8.44%; 死亡病例累计 27(+2), 死亡率 0.88%; 治愈 679(+114)人。犹他州新冠病毒病例的增长基本符合亚指数增长($p=0.52$): <http://castut.org/covid-19/utah0419.png>。过去 14 天平均增长率为每天 4.49%, 过去 7 天为每天 4.56%。郡(区)分布 (格式: 总病例/ 住院/ 死亡): Salt Lake 1,615/ 135/ 15, Utah 455/ 24/ 5, Summit 318/ 31/ 0, Davis 236/ 21/ 2, Weber-Morgan 119/ 13/ 1, Wasatch 111/ 6/ 1, Southwest Utah 66/ 9/ 1, Bear River 54/ 9/ 0, Tooele 42/ 4/ 0, San Juan 22/ 5/ 2, TriCounty 10/ 1/ 0, Central Utah 15/ 1/ 0, Southeast Utah 6/ 0/ 0.

3. 美国企业研究所 (American Enterprise Institute) 关于“国家新冠病毒应对措施：重新开放的路线图”的报告列出了重新开放城市或州的四个基本标准：该州的医院必须能够安全地治疗所有需要住院的患者，而不必诉诸危机标准的护理；该州至少应能够测试每个有症状的人；政府有能力对已确认的病例和接触者进行监测；且病例数量必须持续减少至少 14 天。见 <https://www.aei.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/03/National-Coronavirus-Response-a-Road-Map-to-Recovering-2.pdf>

4. 州卫生厅报告了 Covid-19 种族/族裔数据：截至 4 月 19 日，亚洲人口中有 91 例，占总数的 3%，每 10 万人中有 88.2 例；白人/非西班牙裔或拉丁美洲裔 - 1566 例，占总数的 51%，每 10 万人中有 65.4 例；西班牙裔或拉丁裔 - 940 例，占 30.6%，每 10 万人中有 222.7 例；黑人/非裔美国人 - 55 例，1.8%，104.4 / 100,000。资料来源：

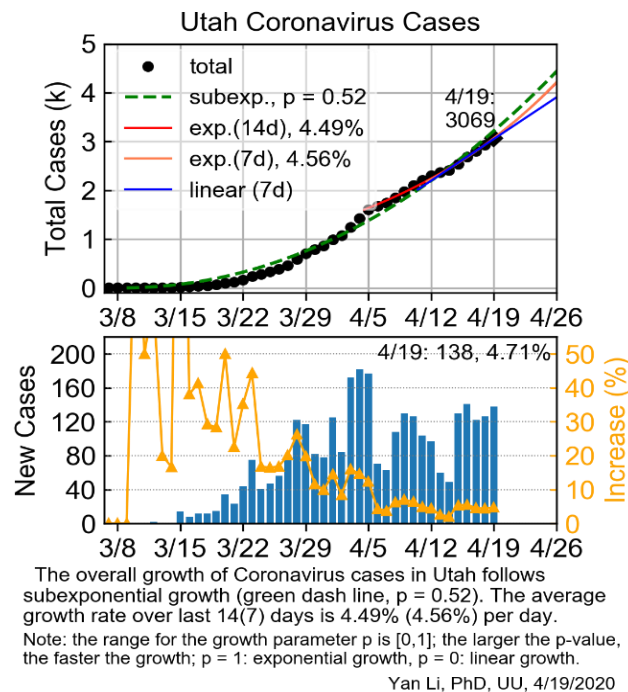

1. U.S. Confirmed Cases: 765,954(+25,696), Deaths: 40,677(+1,613), Recovered:70,337(+4,645).

2. Utah COVID-19 Cases reported by Utah Department of Health as of today: 3,069(+138) confirmed cases total, number of people tested 63,555, positive rate 4.83%; Hospitalization 259(+8), 8.44% of the total cases; death cases 27(+2), death rate 0.88%; recovered cases 679(+114). The growth of coronavirus cases in Utah has been mainly following subexponential growth trend ($p=0.52$):

3. American Enterprise Institute's report on the National Coronavirus Response: A ROAD MAP TO REOPENING listed four benchmarks for reopening cities or states: Hospitals in the state must be able to safely treat all patients requiring hospitalization, without resorting to crisis standards of care; the state needs to be able to at least test everyone who has symptoms; the state is able to conduct monitoring of confirmed cases and contacts; and there must be a sustained reduction in cases for at least 14 days. 4. UDOH reported Covid-19 race/ethnicity data: As of April 19, for Asian population there are 91 cases, 3% of total cases, 88.2 cases per 100,000 population; for White alone/not Hispanic or Latino - 1566 cases, 51% of total, 65.4 cases per 100,000; for Hispanic or Latino - 940 cases, 30.6%, 222.7 per 100,000; for Black/African American - 55 cases, 1.8%, 104.4/100,000. 5. The red cross seeking fully-recovered COVID-19 patients able to donate plasma to help patients with life-threatening infections. To be qualified for donation you have to satisfy the eligibility requirements: 1) You are at least 17 years old and weigh 110 lbs. Additional weight requirements apply for donors age 18 or younger; 2) In good health. You generally feel well, even if you're being treated for a chronic condition; 3) Have a prior, verified diagnosis of COVID-19, but are now symptom free and fully recovered from COVID-19. <https://www.redcrossblood.org/donate-blood/dlp/plasma-donations-from-recovered-covid-19-patients.html>
