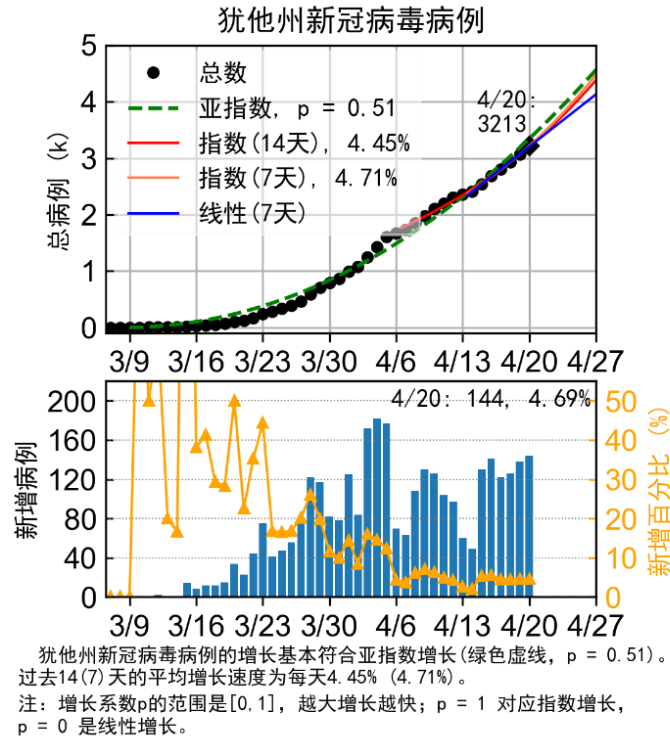

1. 美国 – 截止 6pm MDT, 全国确诊新冠病毒病例: 797,124 (自昨晚 6pm +31,170)。死亡: 42,636(+1,959)。治愈: 72,329(+1,992)。(<https://coronavirus.1point3acres.com/>)
2. 犹他州卫生厅中午公布的确诊新冠病毒病例 3,213(+144)。总共测试 68,311 人, 阳性率 4.70%; 其中住院人数累计 268(+9), 占总病例的 8.34%; 死亡病例累计 28(+1), 死亡率 0.87%; 治愈 776(+97)人。犹他州新冠病毒病例的增长基本符合亚指数增长($p=0.51$): <http://castut.org/covid-19/utah0420.png>。过去 14 天平均增长率为每天 4.45%, 过去 7 天为每天 4.71%。郡(区)分布 (格式: 总病例/ 住院/ 死亡): Salt Lake 1,671/ 140/ 15, Utah 498/ 26/ 5, Summit 331/ 31/ 0, Davis 242/ 21/ 2, Weber-Morgan 124/ 14/ 1, Wasatch 118/ 6/ 1, Southwest Utah 70/ 9/ 1, Bear River 55/ 10/ 1, Tooele 41/ 4/ 0, San Juan 29/ 5/ 2, TriCounty 10/ 1/ 0, Central Utah 17/ 1/ 0, Southeast Utah 7/ 0/ 0.

3. 犹他州议会通过了 SB3004 法案，将建立一个负责在疫情影响下经济问题与公共卫生之间取得平衡的委员会，同时起草“合理的指导方针”，根据该指导方针，医疗保健机构可以恢复提供选择性手术和医疗服务；在经过修改的指导方针下，餐馆也可以恢复正常运营。赫伯特州长签署了 SB3004，并强调了立法机关参与州对冠状病毒危机的应对的重要性。

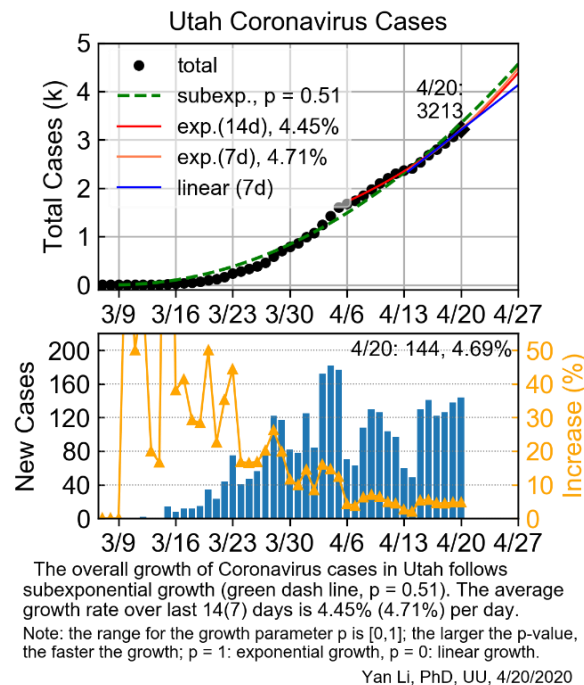

1. U.S. Confirmed Cases: 797,124(+31,170), Deaths: 42,636(+1,959), Recovered:72,329(+1,992).

2. Utah COVID-19 Cases reported by Utah Department of Health as of today: 3,213(+144) confirmed cases total, number of people tested 68,311, positive rate 4.70%; Hospitalization 268(+9), 8.34% of the total cases; death cases 28(+1), death rate 0.87%; recovered cases 776(+97). The growth of coronavirus cases in Utah has been mainly following subexponential growth trend ($p=0.51$):

Distribution in counties/areas in the format of "cases/hospitalization/ death": Salt Lake 1,671/ 140/ 15, Utah 498/ 26/ 5, Summit 331/ 31/ 0, Davis 242/ 21/ 2, Weber-Morgan 124/ 14/ 1, Wasatch 118/ 6/ 1, Southwest Utah 70/ 9/ 1, Bear River 55/ 10/ 1, Tooele 41/ 4/ 0, San Juan 29/ 5/ 2, TriCounty 10/ 1/ 0, Central Utah 17/ 1/ 0, Southeast Utah 7/ 0/ 0.

3. Utah Legislature passed Senate Bill 3004 to create a commission that is charged with balancing economic concerns with public health while drafting “reasonable guidelines” under which health care providers could resume providing elective surgeries and procedures and restaurants could return to normal operations, albeit with modifications. Gov. Herbert signed SB3004 and underscores the importance of the Legislature's participation in the state's response to the coronavirus crisis.

Utah superintendent says · No student should get an F grade this quarter as learning shifts with the coronavirus and they adjust to schools being closed and trying to learn remotely during the coronavirus pandemic.
