

- 1. 美国 截止 6pm MDT, 全国确诊新冠病毒病例: 1,035,727 (自昨晚 6pm +25,555)。死亡: 59,014(+2,398), 治愈: 118,060(+4,490)。 (https://coronavirus.1point3acres.com/)
- 2. 犹他州卫生厅中午公布的确诊新冠病毒病例 4,343(+110), 总共测试 102,439 人, 阳性率 4.24%; 其中住院人数累计 370(+21), 占总病例的 8.52%; 死亡病例累计 45(+4), 死亡率 1.04%; 估计治愈



The overall growth of Coronavirus cases in Utah follows subexponential growth (green dash line, p = 0.48). The average growth rate over last 14(7) days is 4.12% (3.87%) per day. 1. U.S. Confirmed Cases:1,035,727(+25,555), Deaths: 59,014(+2,398), Recovered: 118,060(+4,490). (https://coronavirus.1point3acres.com/).

2. Utah COVID-19 Cases reported by Utah Department of Health as of today: 4,343(+110) confirmed cases total, number of people tested 102,439, positive rate 4.24%; Hospitalization 370(+21), 8.52% of the total cases; death cases 45(+4), death rate 1.04%; estimated recovered cases 1,704(+65). The average growth is 4.12% per day for the last 14 days, and 3.87% for the last 7 days. - 3. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention added six symptoms of the novel coronavirus to its list, suggesting health experts are learning more about the growing number of ways physicians see the virus affecting patients. The symptoms, which the CDC reports could appear two to 14 days after exposure to the virus, are: Chills, Repeated shaking with chills, Muscle pain, Headache, Sore throat, New loss of taste or smell. - 4. Starting Friday May 1, Utah will transition from a state of high risk for COVID-19 to a state of moderate risk, Gov. Herbert announced Tuesday. The transition will give the state an opportunity to open up some aspects of its economy, but it means there will still be risks to the public for COVID-19, we still need to keep social distancing and other protective measures. - 5. The Salt Lake County Health Department said it would follow Governor Herbert's recommendations for a phased-in re-opening of some businesses and loosening of some restrictions because of COVID-19. Reopening is, of course, contingent on the latest data we receive about the spread of the virus locally, and our reopening date could change if virus transmission increases in Salt Lake County. - 6. Washington County Commission Chairman announced plans on April 27, to reopen for businesses on Friday, May 1, at least as much as state guidelines will allow. Director of the Southwest Utah Public Health Department said data shows it is safe to start reopening businesses there as long as some safe distancing and similar measures continue to be followed. "It's been two weeks since anyone has been hospitalized from COVID here." No one currently is hospitalized. The area had 87 active cases, 2 deaths, 58 have recovered (65% recovery rate).
