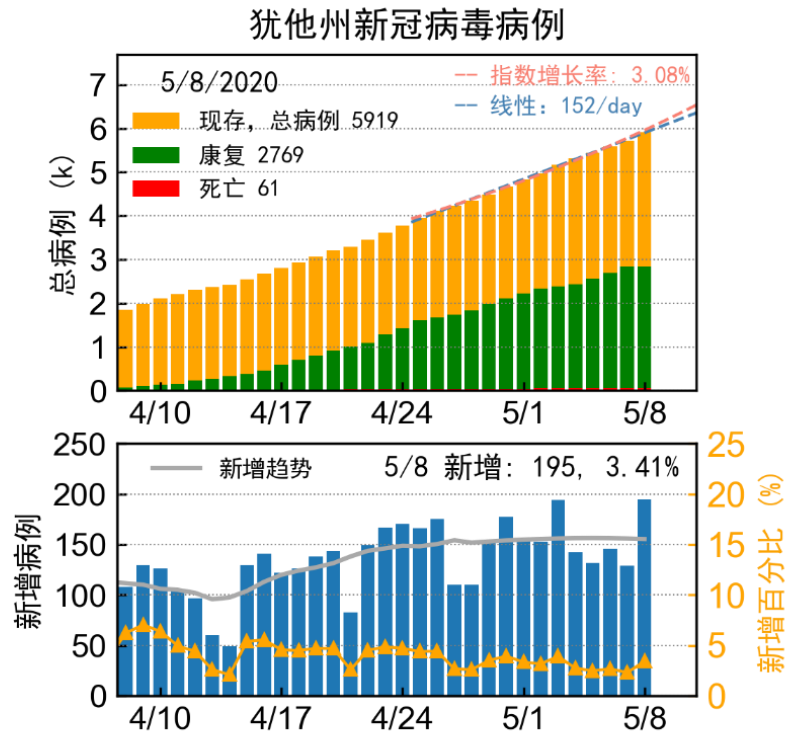

犹他州新冠病毒病例, 过去14(7)天的平均增长速度为每天3.08% (2.74%)。

1. 美国 – 截止 6pm MDT, 全国确诊新冠病毒病例: 1,319,678 (总数比五月五号增加 84,383, 平均每天增加 28,128)。死亡: 78,316(总数增加 6,285, 平均每天增加 2,095), 治愈: 183,063(总数增加 19,031, 平均每天增加 6,344)。(<https://coronavirus.1point3acres.com/>)

2. 犹他州卫生厅中午公布的确诊新冠病毒病例 5,919, 总共测试 138,688 人, 阳性率 4.27%; 其中住院人数累计 488, 占总病例的 8.24%; 死亡病例累计 61, 死亡率 1.03%; 估计治愈 2,769 人。过去 14 天平均增长率为每天 3.08%, 过去 7 天为每天 2.74%。过去 14 天, 新增病例平均每天 152 例。<http://castut.org/covid-19/utah0508.png>. 郡(区)分布 (格式: 总病例/ 住院/ 死亡) : Salt Lake 3,104/ 280/ 39, Utah 1,288/ 71/ 11, Summit 384/ 33/ 0, Davis 321/ 27/ 2, Weber-Morgan 184/ 23/ 2, Wasatch 173/ 7/ 1, Southwest Utah 138/ 13/ 3, San Juan 135/ 14/ 2, Tooele 72/ 6/ 0, Bear River 66/ 11/ 1, Central Utah 27/ 2/ 0, TriCounty 14/ 1/ 0, Southeast Utah 13/ 0/ 0.

3. 死亡和住院摘要：在过去的 7 天中，犹他州共有 15 例 COVID-19 死亡，这是最高的一周死亡人数。5 月 1 日的总死亡人数为 46 例，5 月 8 日的总死亡人数为 61 例。其中 6 例是男性，9 例是女性。85 岁或以上的年龄为 5 例，61-84 岁为 6 例；60 岁或以下为 4 例；12 人有基础病；死亡前有 9 人住院；6 例死亡与长期护理机构有关。犹他总共有 476 例住院，但目前只有 92 人仍在住院。资料来源：<https://www.sltrib.com/news/2020/05/08/live-coronavirus-updates>

4. 犹他州卫生厅公布了病例感染源的初步调查结果：在医疗机构内感染占总病例 2%，旅行 3.7%，不明来源州内感染 16.1%，已知接触感染 60.5%，不明来源/正在调查 17.7%。卫生厅还报告了所有病例在感染 COVID-19 之前的既往疾病：有既往疾病者占有已患新冠肺炎病例的 44.5%；14.6% 的前吸烟者；当前吸烟者为 5.4%；慢性肺病 10.9%；糖尿病 9.4%；心血管疾病 7.1%。约有 72.3% 的住院患者患有至少一种既往疾病；糖尿病 31.3%；心血管 23.3%；前吸烟者 20%；慢性肺 17%；免疫受损 12.4%；慢性肾脏病 10.5%。见 <https://coronavirus-dashboard.utah.gov/#risk-factors-and-exposures>

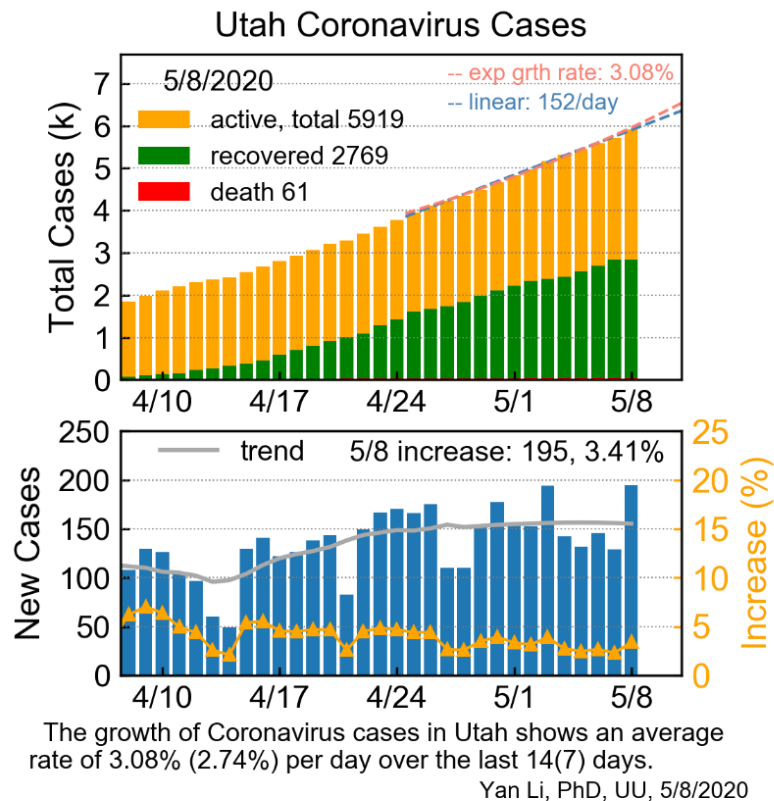

1. U.S. Confirmed Cases: 1,319,678(+84,383, or +28,128 per day from 05/06 to 05/08), Deaths: 78,316(+6,285, or +2,095 per day), Recovered: 183,063(+19,031, or +6,344 per day). (<https://coronavirus.1point3acres.com/>).

2. Utah COVID-19 Cases reported by Utah Department of Health as of today: 5,919 confirmed cases total, number of people tested 138,688, positive rate 4.27%; Hospitalization 488, 8.24% of the total cases; death cases 61, death rate 1.03%; estimated recovered cases 2,769. The average growth is 3.08% per day over the last 14 days, and 2.74% over the last 7 days. On average, there are 152 new cases per day over last 14 days. <http://www.castut.org/covid-19/utah0508en.png>. 3. Summary of Deaths and Hospitalization: In the last 7 days, Utah had 15 COVID-19 deaths, the highest weekly death toll. The total deaths were 46 on May 1 and 61 on May 8. Among the 15 new deaths, 6 of them were male, 9 were female; Age of 85 or older was 5, 61-84 was 6; 60 or younger was 4; 12 with underlying conditions; 9 were hospitalized before deaths; 6 deaths were associated with long-term care. There are a total of 476 hospitalizations, but currently only 92 people are hospitalized. Source:

The Utah Department of Health published the statistics of primary investigated exposure sources as follows: Healthcare 2%, Travel 3.7%, In-state without know contact 16.1%, Know contact 60.5%, Unknown/Under Investigation 17.7%. DOH also reported pre-existing conditions of all COVID-19 cases: 44.5% of all cases with a pre-existing condition; 14.6% former smoker; 5.4% current smoker; 10.9% chronic pulmonary; 9.4% diabetes; 7.1% cardiovascular diseases. About 72.3% of hospitalized patients have at least one pre-existing condition; Diabetes 31.3%; Cardiovascular 23.3%; Former Smoker 20%; Chronic Pulmonary 17%; Immunocompromised 12.4%; Chronic kidney disease 10.5%.
